
Cleaning Instructions

DO NOT SCHEDULE A CARPET CLEANING; HPM WILL DO THIS AFTER YOU HAVE VACATED

KITCHEN:

Range, Oven and Hood - Including under burners, oven rack, bottom oven drawer, and replace or clean drip pans.
Refrigerator - Defrost and clean, turn to low (DO NOT TURN OFF), clean top of fridge too.
Dishwasher – wipe inside door and all edges, outside, run a final empty load to clean any residual.
Sink, Tile, and Countertops
Cabinets – Inside, out and on top.
Floor – Make sure flooring under the cabinets, along the base trim are clean.
Walls
Ceiling – Wipe down the ceiling

BATHROOM:

Shower/Tub Area
Toilet (use a pumice stone to remove toilet rings)
Sink, Mirror and Cabinets
Floor (thoroughly cleaned but not waxed)
Bath exhaust fan - vacuum and clean
Light Fixtures
Walls, trim, and behind toilet
Remove hair from all drains
Remove used shower curtain and dispose.
Use bleach solution to remove any mold/mildew

WINDOWS:

Wash inside and outside
Clean all blind slats individually
Window tracks & sills

MISCELLANEOUS:

Baseboards, heat registers, light fixtures, walls, windows and sliding tracks, fireplace (where applicable), vacuum carpets, clean grounds or yard (if applicable).

Clean all trim and walls to remove smudges and stains (**Mr. Clean Magic Eraser** is excellent). Clean windows and sills. Do not repaint or restain, this could result in repainting charges.

Clean all floors and glass surfaces. All scuff marks and stains should be removed (Magic Eraser).

Remove all trash and dust from cabinets, shelves and closets. Do not leave any personal furniture, clothing, trash, etc... All items will be hauled away and the cost will be taken from the damage deposit.
